## WHAT IS HOME VISITATION?

Home Visitation is a program for families who are parenting for the first time. We accept families during pregnancy or with infants up to three months old. A practitioner visits the family in their home and provides information and support about child development, parenting and community resources. Parents participate on a voluntary basis. Home visitation provides a positive opportunity for parents to raise their children in a healthy, safe and secure environment.

## HOME VISITATION...

- Helps families balance daily issues with parenting.
- Promotes healthy attachments between parents and children.
- Works with individuals' needs and strengths.
- Is provided by an experienced, knowledgeable and flexible practitioner.
- Reaches isolated families who may not have access to other supports.

## HOW TO GET INVOLVED WITH HOME VISITATION

- Ask a community health nurse to make a referral.
- Make a self-referral.
